## ABOUT THE ARIZONA INDIGENOUS CULINARY EXPERIENCE

The Arizona American Indian Tourism Association (AAITA) will host the annual Arizona Indigenous Culinary Experience event held at the Museum of the West in Downtown Scottsdale in conjunction with Native American Heritage month on November 22-23, 2024.

The sixth annual Arizona Indigenous Culinary Experience is a cocktail format event which includes tasting stations featuring traditional and fusion foods and cocktails by indigenous chefs and foragers, utilizing the very gems of flora and fauna that are grown and harvested right here in Arizona.

This year's event will include the Arizona Indigenous Food Symposium on November 22 a trans-formative event dedicated to celebrating and revitalizing food traditions.

The Arizona Indigenous Culinary Experience partnership with the Arizona Indian Festival (AIF) and Scottsdale Western Week in February generated a total sponsorship marketing value of over \$3 hundred thousand in partner media value and more than 6 million impressions and generated 350 media spots through print, web, television and social media.
